Hello all,

I was hoping to get at least a draft of our Proposed School Closing Scenario document put together today, but I was held late at another meeting and just got back to the office. However, I will be working on the document over the weekend. I'm going to mark it as a "DRAFT", review it with Dennis and send it to the three of you for review before Monday morning. I will then make suggested edits and resend to everyone involved in the 'Action Team' before the end of day, Monday Jan. 21.

We have begun the boundary shifts and school profiles for the scenario, which we'll need for confidence in the remaining facilities capacity to handle the displaced students. I will summarize the assumptions and results of this analysis in our report, which will most likely be offered in narrative format as opposed to specific numbers (like we saw today). In other words, I'm going to speak to the ability of District 279 to handle the Proposed School Closings without exceeding the remaining facility footprints (building capacities).
